Christmas Crime Prevention Tips

Keep Christmas crime free

When Shopping

1. Make sure your handbag, purse or wallet is out of sight.
2. Never leave your bag unattended.
3. Keep pin confidential and protect from view at a cashpoint.
4. Secure vehicle.
5. If you have to keep presents in a car place in the boot and secure the car.
6. Park in a well-lit area or attended car park.

At Home

1. Do not leave presents under the tree in view of a window.
2. Mark valuable presents with your postcode.
3. Dispose of present packaging carefully as empty boxes left outside can advertise that you have new goods inside.
4. Secure house and outbuildings.
5. Do not leave keys in doors or displayed on a hook or where they are visible.
6. When you go out at night leave some lights on with curtains drawn. For additional effect you can leave a radio on. You can purchase programmable time switches to come on during times when you are usually at home.
7. Do not open your door if you do not recognise or are not expecting the caller.

Out and About

Don't drink or Drive.

Think of your own safety – it is more important than material belongings.

For other calls call 101 or if not an emergency contact your local Beat Team.
